

Quiz Correction Guidelines

Math 290: Elementary Linear Algebra, Fall 2018

A student may earn at most half of the points missed on quizzes, adhering to the following guidelines:

1. Only corrections to **full-page** quizzes can be submitted.
2. Only students **present** for a quiz may submit corrections.
3. Corrections must be submitted on the **next** class period after the quiz is returned. If you miss this class period, it is your responsibility to turn in the corrections before the class period begins.
4. Corrections should be submitted on **separate** sheets of paper, and **stapled** to the original quiz.
5. Students must submit corrections for **every part** of a problem that is incorrect.

For every incorrect part, each correction should be formatted as follows.

1. Must **restate** the question that was missed.
2. Must contain a section titled “**Where I went wrong.**” This section should contain a description of where/why errors were made. It can be brief, but should be thoughtful, and taken seriously.
3. Must contain a section titled “**Correct answer,**” in which the student includes all correct steps *in their own words* (without looking at solutions), taking care to justify all steps. In this section, student should indicate how far they got on the original quiz, if applicable.

Students are welcome to consult with me before submitting their corrections. The amount of credit received by students will depend on the quality of their submission, and at most half the points missed. A resubmission containing errors, or that does not follow the guidelines, will not receive credit.
